Bangarra dancer Jasmin Sheppard created the work *Macq* acknowledging a moment in our past, exploring the historical chapter that devastated the Dharawal people of Appin in 1816, under the direction of Governor Macquarie. Bangarra will perform this passionate and political work for the South-West Sydney community, bringing it back to Country – to the land that inspired it.

Come along for a free community BBQ from 4.30pm until 6.00pm followed by local performances and Bangarra's *Macq* as the sun goes down in the Amphitheatre.

Bring the family, grab a picnic blanket and get down early to secure a spot. This is an alcohol and smoking free event.
